Lab Technician Positions

The Aquatics and Wetlands research lab collects and analyzes water samples from lakes, rivers, reservoirs, and wetlands across Iowa. We are searching to hire both undergraduate and recent graduates to work as student technicians and seasonal technicians respectively in the summer of 2023. Technicians would be responsible for conducting a variety of water quality analyses under supervision, as well as lab maintenance and clean up. Workers will receive training on a variety of lab instruments including Auto Titrator and Spectrometers and will need to complete all safety trainings in compliance with EH&S (Employee Health & Safety).

Positions will be full-time through the summer and there will be potential for part-time work in the fall. Undergraduate technicians start at \$15/hr and Seasonal technicians at \$17/hr.

Field Technician Positions

Technicians will spend some days in the field, and some days performing laboratory analysis or maintenance. All technicians will be given CPR training (unless pre-existing certification is presented)
