Where will I spend my summer?

Interns can choose between 7 locations: Iowa State Univ. (Ames), Univ. of Illinois (Champaign or Galesburg), Univ. of Nebraska (Lincoln) North Dakota State Univ. (Fargo), South Dakota State Univ. (Aberdeen), Univ. of Wisconsin (Milwaukee)

How much does it pay?

Internships are full time, paid (\$15/hour) in addition to up to \$1,000 reimbursement for travel, and \$3,400 for room and board.

Who is eligible?

US Citizens/ permanent residents & current undergraduate students with at least one year of undergraduate coursework completed and at least one semester of course work remaining after the summer internship. Must have valid US drivers license.

How long is the internship?

3 months — flexible start and end date between May and August
