Where will I spend my summer?

Interns can choose between 6 locations: Iowa State University (Ames), University of Illinois (Champaign or Galesburg), University of Nebraska (Lincoln) North Dakota State University (Fargo), University of Missouri (Columbia), University of Wisconsin (Milwaukee)

How much does it pay?

Internships are full time, paid (\$15/hour) in addition to up to \$1,000 reimbursement for travel, and up to \$3,400 for room and board.

Who is eligible?

US Citizens/ permanent residents & current undergraduate students with at least one year of undergraduate coursework completed and at least one semester of course work remaining after the summer internship. Must have valid US driver's license and be willing and able to drive independently.

How long is the internship?

3 months — flexible start and end date between May and August
