Below is a link for TWO great seasonal bio. tech positions at Rydell and Glacial Ridge NWRs in Erskine, MN. One position is for 5 months and the other is for 3 months. The 3-month position is great for someone who'll be returning to school next fall. The 5-month position would be great for a recent grad, or someone who will be graduating this May. In addition to competitive weekly stipends, these positions offer free housing at Rydell Refuge, opportunity for an AmeriCorps Education Award, and opportunity for federal Public Land Corps Hiring Authority.

Although both of these positions have an invasive species focus, we always have a wide variety of projects and experiences that we make available to all of our seasonal staff.
