

**U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Mississippi River Project
Student Trainee (General) Vacancies:**

Why apply:

- **Gain experience** in Natural Resources and Recreation career field.
- **See unique areas on Project** along the internationally significant wetland and Globally Important Bird Area that is the Upper Mississippi River and floodplain, also home to three U.S. Fish and Wildlife National Wildlife Refuges and Wildlife Management Areas in three states.
- It can **jumpstart your Natural Resources Management career**, while still in school!

Information: Positions are open to current students pursuing a qualifying degree or certificate in an accredited college (including 4-year colleges/universities, community colleges, and junior colleges). For this internship, you **MUST** be able to work full-time during the parks peak season (mid-late May through the end of September, or when school starts). Most of the positions will work weekends and holidays with hours of work scheduled for day and nighttime. These intern positions are designed to prepare a student trainee for employment after graduation in a role such as a Park Ranger or Natural Resource Specialist (Ranger). Pathways Internship positions will be assigned tasks designed to increase familiarity with the target occupation in a real-world work environment. At the full-performance level, you will be expected to:

- Answer routine questions concerning recreation facilities, project operations, and visitor regulations;
- Meet the visiting public and provides general assistance and recreational information concerning available facilities and recreational opportunities;
- Complete Environmental Stewardship field work, forest data collection, and natural resource management site monitoring in remote Project locations accessed by truck, boat, and foot; and/or
- Assist in conducting inspections of shoreline use permits for compliance and safety.
